A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the United Nations Children’s Fund (UNICEF) is a key partner in global efforts to ensure that life-saving COVID-19 vaccines reach people in developing countries and in humanitarian and conflict situations, and

WHEREAS donations made to UNICEF Canada’s COVID-19 vaccination fundraising campaign will help deliver vaccines to destination countries, keep vaccines viable during the journey, and train local health care workers to effectively administer the vaccines, and

WHEREAS in support of the largest vaccine procurement and supply operation in human history, the Government of Canada announced it will match, dollar for dollar, donations made by individual Canadians to UNICEF Canada’s COVID-19 vaccination fundraising campaign, and

WHEREAS this matching fund campaign, called “Give A Vax,” will run to September 6, 2021, and

WHEREAS Give a Vax Month is an opportunity to raise awareness of these and other fundraising campaigns to help ensure that no vaccine dose goes to waste;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that August 2021 shall be known as

“Give a Vax Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
