ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Giving Tuesday is a national day of giving in Canada that takes place on the Tuesday following Cyber Monday, and

WHEREAS Giving Tuesday is a celebration of philanthropy and volunteerism where people give whatever they are able to give, and

WHEREAS Giving Tuesday is a day where citizens work together to share commitments, rally for favourite causes, build a stronger community and think about other people, and

WHEREAS it is fitting and proper on Giving Tuesday and on every day to recognize the tremendous impact of philanthropy, volunteerism and community service in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS Giving Tuesday is an opportunity to encourage citizens to serve others throughout this holiday season and during other times of the year;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 27, 2018 shall be known as

“Giving Tuesday”

in the Province of British Columbia.
