ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS the day after the Humboldt Broncos bus crash, Logan Boulet succumbed to his injuries but, having registered as an organ donor and shared this decision with his family, gave the gift of life to others, inspiring thousands of people around the world to register as organ and tissue donors, and

WHEREAS despite an increased number of organ donors, many Canadians still need an organ or tissue transplant and some die waiting each year, and

WHEREAS Logan Boulet's family, the Canadian Transplant Association, BC Transplant, donor families, transplant recipients and health care providers carry on Logan's legacy by encouraging everyone to wear green on the anniversary of his donation to raise awareness of the need for registered organ and tissue donors and the need for them to share their decisions with family, to improve access to life-saving and life-transforming transplants, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia and BC Transplant are committed to raising awareness and sharing information about the need for organs so that more lives can be saved and improved, and more families have the gift of time with their loved ones;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 7, 2022, shall be known as




in the Province of British Columbia.
