A Proclamation

CHARLES THE THIRD, by the Grace of God, King of Canada
and His other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS in British Columbia, health care assistants include a variety of workers such as health care aides and community support workers, and

WHEREAS over 52 000 health care assistants hold an active registration with the BC Care Aide & Community Health Worker Registry, and

WHEREAS health care assistants provide personal care assistance and promote the well-being of their clients in a variety of settings, including acute care, long-term care, home and community care, independent living and assisted living, and

WHEREAS health care assistants have demonstrated that they are essential members of the health care team and provide excellent service at the point of care to support the safety and quality of healthcare for patients, residents, clients and all people in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS the demand for health care assistants is ever increasing with the aging of British Columbia's population and the continual growth of health care services, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia wishes to join with people across the province to recognize health care assistants;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that October 18, 2024, shall be known as


“Health Care Assistant Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
