ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the Province of British Columbia annually recognizes the importance of protecting and conserving our rich and diverse heritage by proclaiming Heritage Week, and

WHEREAS the theme for Heritage Week 2019 is The Tie that Binds, and

WHEREAS British Columbia celebrates the past and future by embracing, exploring and enjoying our enduring heritage, and

WHEREAS British Columbia acknowledges Indigenous culture has existed since time immemorial, and is inextricably woven into memory, culture, place and practice, and

WHEREAS British Columbia acknowledges that people from all walks of life and from every community contribute to our rich cultural heritage;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that February 18 to 24, 2019 shall be known as


“Heritage Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
