A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the Government of Canada has enacted the *Ukrainian Famine and Genocide (“Holodomor”) Memorial Day Act*, and

WHEREAS this Act commemorates the anniversary of the Great Famine of 1932–1933, and

WHEREAS the Act says that “[t]hroughout Canada, in each and every year, the fourth Saturday in November shall be known as ‘Ukrainian Famine and Genocide (“Holodomor”) Memorial Day’”;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 23, 2019, shall be known as

**“Holodomor Memorial Day”**

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.

WITNESS, The Honourable Janet Austin, Lieutenant Governor of Our Province of British Columbia, in Our City of Victoria, in Our Province, this ninth day of October, two thousand nineteen and in the sixty-eighth year of Our Reign.
