ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the work of health services providers has an impact on every aspect of the lives of British Columbians,
and

WHEREAS the duties performed by health services providers include a wide range of occupations in the areas of
residential care, assisted living, home and community care, rehabilitation services, public health, mental health and
addictions services, laboratory services, support work, acute care, emergency care, maternity and primary healthcare,
and

WHEREAS all frontline, support and administrative workers are essential to British Columbians' health, well-being
and longevity, and

WHEREAS many health services providers do not receive any recognition for the important duties they perform,
and

WHEREAS there is a definite need to raise awareness of the tireless work done by all health services providers in all
settings;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that January 2018 shall be known as


“Health Services Providers Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
