WHEREAS the British Columbia Association of Healthcare Auxiliaries has 76 member auxiliaries representing 5690 adults and 506 young people all of whom enhance health care for British Columbians through volunteerism and community involvement, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia Association of Healthcare Auxiliaries has been working diligently since 1945 to strengthen its member auxiliaries through education, information and support, and

WHEREAS in 2017, member auxiliaries reported approximately 1,076,597 volunteer hours and \$8,809,397.23 donated;

**“Healthcare Auxiliary Day”**


in the Province of British Columbia.
