ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the Government of Canada has enacted the *Ukrainian Famine and Genocide (“Holodomor”) Memorial Day Act*, and

WHEREAS this Act commemorates the anniversary of the Great Famine of 1932-1933, and

WHEREAS the Act says that “Throughout Canada, in each and every year, the fourth Saturday in November shall be known as “Ukrainian Famine and Genocide (“Holodomor”) Memorial Day”, and

WHEREAS 2018 marks the 85th anniversary of the Ukrainian Famine and Genocide;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 24, 2018 shall be known as


“Holodomor Memorial Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
