A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS major trauma or injury is the principal cause of death for people under 45 years of age in Canada, and

WHEREAS most injuries are predictable and preventable, and Parachute is Canada's national charity dedicated to reducing the devastating impact of preventable injuries for people on the road, at home and at play by providing them with the necessary information and tools, and

WHEREAS all British Columbians have an equal right to education on and awareness of injury care, control and prevention strategies, and

WHEREAS July 5, 2021, marks the fifth annual National Injury Prevention Day (NIPD)—a day of awareness, education and advocacy led by Parachute and its partners, including the BC Injury Research and Prevention Unit, and

WHEREAS Injury Prevention Day is an opportunity to raise awareness of and increase education on injury prevention, including the need for system-wide changes, and to advocate for all British Columbians to live long and full lives;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that July 5, 2021, shall be known as

“Injury Prevention Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.


