A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the last day of February is recognized as Rare Disease Day internationally, with the purpose to bring about awareness of rare diseases and their impact on patients' lives amongst the general public and decision makers, and

WHEREAS a rare disease is defined as a condition affecting fewer than one in 2,000 people, and

WHEREAS there are more than 7,000 diagnosed rare diseases and about one in 12 people (nearly three million Canadians) have a rare disease, and

WHEREAS despite the numbers, there is no cure for the majority of rare diseases and many go undiagnosed, and

WHEREAS Rare Disease Day improves knowledge amongst the general public of rare diseases while encouraging researchers and decision makers to address the needs of those living with rare diseases, and

WHEREAS the Province of British Columbia values our citizens with rare diseases and their families, and

WHEREAS the Rare Disease Foundation is dedicated to promoting awareness, research and education and supporting individuals with rare diseases and their families, and

WHEREAS the Rare Disease Foundation wishes to join the Province of British Columbia in dedicating one day in the year to rare disease awareness. Please help us to spread the word;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that February 28, 2019 shall be known as

“International Rare Disease Awareness Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
