ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day is a day to focus on the profound positive influence intergenerational connecting has on eliminating isolation and loneliness, and moving towards healthy, all-age friendly communities, and

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day is a day to celebrate all of the good things presently taking place between generations in local communities, and

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day does not require funding, excessive time or extensive planning, but rather comes from the people for the people, and

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day is an official reminder and invitation for every citizen to take one small respectful step to bridge generations within his or her local community;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that June 1, 2018 shall be known as


“Intergenerational Day”
