ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day is meant to raise awareness about the power of making simple, respectful intergenerational connections, and

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day is a day to celebrate the profound positive influence that intergenerational connecting has on eliminating isolation and loneliness and on moving towards healthy, all-age friendly communities, and

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day celebrates the good things presently taking place between generations in local communities, and

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day encourages simple, fun intergenerational sharing, and

WHEREAS Intergenerational Day is a reminder and invitation for everyone to take one small, respectful step to bridge generations within their local communities;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that June 1, 2021, shall be known as

“Intergenerational Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
