WHEREAS Intergenerational Day is an official reminder and a yearly invitation for every citizen to take one small, respectful step to bridge generations within the citizen's local community;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that June 1, 2019 shall be known as

“Intergenerational Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.


