ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the Royal Canadian Legion is Canada's primary non-governmental organization that advocates for veterans and offers volunteer leadership opportunities at local branches to serve the community and families in need, and

WHEREAS the BC/Yukon Command of the Royal Canadian Legion represents tens of thousands of veterans and their families and relatives in British Columbia and Yukon, and

WHEREAS each branch of the BC/Yukon Command of the Royal Canadian Legion has evolved in partnership with local communities to adapt their diverse services to the changing needs and interests of their respective communities, and

WHEREAS an annual community celebration, Legion Week is an opportunity to learn more about Canadian military history and to recognize the Royal Canadian Legion's commitment to veterans and to communities across British Columbia;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that October 10 to 16, 2021, shall be known as

“Legion Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.
