ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the British Columbia Ministry of Health recognizes the vital contributions of the many people who work in the medical laboratory system—including medical laboratory assistants, medical laboratory technologists, combined laboratory x-ray technologists, laboratory medicine physicians and others—to provincial health care and to the health and wellness of all in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS people in medical laboratory occupations perform a key role in British Columbia's health care system that directly supports patient health and decisions related to patient care, including by contributing to the laboratory collection, testing and evaluation needs of all British Columbians—individuals, families, groups, populations and entire communities—in a wide range of settings, and

WHEREAS Medical Laboratory Week is an opportunity to recognize and acknowledge the expertise and dedication of those in medical laboratory occupations, as well as to encourage others to enter these valuable occupations;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 10 to 16, 2022, shall be known as

“Medical Laboratory Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
