A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS in British Columbia, registered midwives are regulated professionals who are trained, educated and committed to the health and well-being of pregnant people, infants and families; who are experts in healthy pregnancy, birth and post-natal care; who provide assessment, monitoring and care for pregnant people; and who enable options for labour, in hospital and at home, and delivery of healthy newborns, and

WHEREAS as members of the primary care team, midwives not only are well positioned to address the challenge of bringing normal pregnancy closer to home, but also have an increasingly important role in strengthening the health care system and are an important part of team-based health care in urban, rural and remote communities, and

WHEREAS International Day of the Midwife was first celebrated on May 5, 1992, and is now observed in more than 50 countries around the world, including Canada, and

WHEREAS midwives improve pregnancy and child health outcomes, and the World Health Organization, the United Nations Population Fund, the United Nations Children's Fund and the World Bank agree that midwives are essential to achieving the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals to reduce maternal and newborn mortality, and

WHEREAS Midwives Day is an opportunity to recognize and celebrate the work of midwives in providing safe and quality maternity care for pregnant people and families across British Columbia;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 5, 2022, shall be known as

“Midwives Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.


