ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS British Columbia's climate and scenery make motorcycle riding an attraction in this beautiful province, and riders consider British Columbia's roadways some of the best for motorcycle riding, and

WHEREAS motorcycles are an increasingly popular means of transportation for commuting, touring and recreation; and they are energy-efficient vehicles that reduce fuel consumption, traffic and parking congestion, and

WHEREAS as a matter of safety, it is necessary to develop appropriate driving habits to handle these vehicles on British Columbia's roadways, and

WHEREAS to prevent injuries and deaths on British Columbia's roadways, motorcyclists and motorists must be vigilant in their efforts to share the road and ensure the safety of everyone, and

WHEREAS Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month raises public awareness about motorcycles and encourages their safe and proper use among motorcycle riders for a lifetime of safe motorcycle riding;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 2021 shall be known as

**“Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month”**

in the Province of British Columbia.
