A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS British Columbia's climate and scenery make motorcycle riding an attraction in the beautiful province of British Columbia, and riders consider our roadways to be some of the best for riding, and

WHEREAS motorcycles are increasingly used as a regular means of transportation, and

WHEREAS the motorcycle is an energy-efficient vehicle that reduces fuel consumption, traffic and parking congestion, and

WHEREAS the motorcycle is an important form of transportation for commuting, touring and recreation, and

WHEREAS, as a matter of safety, it is necessary to develop appropriate driving habits to handle these vehicles on British Columbia roadways, and

WHEREAS, to prevent injuries and deaths on British Columbia's roadways, motorcyclists and motorists must be vigilant in their efforts to share the road and ensure the safety of everyone, and

WHEREAS Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month raises public awareness for a lifetime of safe motorcycle riding, and

WHEREAS Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month is designed to increase public awareness about motorcycles and to encourage their safe and proper use among motorcycle riders;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 2019 shall be known as

“Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
