ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS music in British Columbian schools and communities encompasses over 150 years of Canada's vibrant cultural diversity, and

WHEREAS hundreds of thousands of people across Canada will raise their voices to celebrate music in their schools and communities on Music Monday, and

WHEREAS music education is part of a comprehensive education for British Columbia's students that can lead to opportunity and prosperity through creativity and collaborative skills, and

WHEREAS more than 40 000 students and teachers in British Columbia's schools will contribute to a nationwide performance and demonstration of unity on Music Monday, and

WHEREAS Music Monday is an opportunity for everyone in British Columbia and across Canada to celebrate and be proud of their musical heritage and future;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 3, 2021, shall be known as

“Music Monday”

in the Province of British Columbia.
