ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS it is desirable that employers, workers and the community at large be made aware of the need to undertake basic organizational and cultural changes in the workplace to reduce the incidence of occupational injuries and illnesses, and

WHEREAS the Province of British Columbia, through WorkSafeBC (the Workers' Compensation Board) and other provincial agencies, supports individuals and organizations who are committed to safer working practices in their efforts to develop and promote those safer working practices and to raise public awareness of workplace hazards, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia and Yukon region of the Canadian Society of Safety Engineering and the NAOSH Week Steering Committee-BC, together with the Province of British Columbia and its agencies, promote the open communication of occupational health and safety information among workers and employers;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 5 to 11, 2019 shall be known as


“North American Occupational Safety and Health Week”
