ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS engineering and geoscience are regulated professions under the *Professional Governance Act*, and professional engineers and professional geoscientists must meet robust education, experience, professional and ethical standards, and

WHEREAS engineers and geoscientists perform vital work every day for the people of British Columbia, creating world-class innovations and technologies that support the provincial economy and create a safer world for everyone, and

WHEREAS women are under-represented in these professions, and Engineers and Geoscientists BC is committed to meeting Engineers Canada's 30 by 30 goal by increasing the number of women working in these professions to 30% by 2030, and

WHEREAS cultivating a deep, diverse and innovative talent pool today will help the communities and economies of tomorrow to thrive, and

WHEREAS National Engineering and Geoscience Month is an opportunity to highlight the role engineering and geoscience play in shaping communities, and to encourage young people—especially young women—across Canada to consider careers in these dynamic professions;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that March 2021 shall be known as

“National Engineering and Geoscience Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.


