ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS October 31, 2021, is a day when Canadians can change the life of a child in need, and

WHEREAS since the 2014 National UNICEF Day campaign, Canadians—including British Columbians—have helped UNICEF provide critical educational supplies to millions of children in the world’s most inaccessible places, and

WHEREAS October 31, 2021, continues the National UNICEF Day campaign to raise money to ensure that every child has access to a quality education that leads to lifelong opportunities and advances individual and global development, and

WHEREAS with the support of British Columbians, UNICEF is committed to helping children around the world grow up healthy, educated and safe, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia recognizes the significance of British Columbians’ interest in and support for UNICEF’s important work;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that October 31, 2021, shall be known as

“National UNICEF Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
