ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS volunteer board directors steer agencies that are the heartbeat of their communities, and

WHEREAS many non-profit organizations in British Columbia are required to have an elected volunteer board of at least 3 directors who are accountable to the public, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's diverse and accomplished volunteer board directors have significant legal and financial responsibilities, collectively overseeing billions of dollars in public, charitable and private funding, and

WHEREAS non-profit community boards throughout British Columbia are dedicated to strengthening community social health, and the Board Voice Society of BC is a member-based organization for non-profit social services community boards, and

WHEREAS Non-Profit Volunteer Boards Day is an opportunity to recognize the vital role that volunteer board directors play in governing the organizations that ensure the health and wellbeing of people and communities in British Columbia;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 24, 2022, shall be known as

“Non-Profit Volunteer Boards Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
