ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS oncology nurses are committed to providing quality cancer care, and

WHEREAS oncology nurses have demonstrated excellence in patient care, teaching, research, administration and education in the field of oncology nursing, and

WHEREAS oncology nurses endeavour to educate the public on the prevention and treatment of cancer, and

WHEREAS oncology nurses help people with cancer and their loved ones to live as well as possible after a cancer diagnosis, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia urges all British Columbians to join in observance of Oncology Nursing Day and participate in activities to recognize the special contributions that oncology nurses provide to the public;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 5, 2022, shall be known as

“Oncology Nursing Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
