A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS Pulmonary Fibrosis is a rare, progressive and unpredictable lung disease associated with uncontrolled fibroproliferation that results in progressive decline in lung function and the majority of patients dying from respiratory failure within three to five years, and

WHEREAS up to 14,000 people are living with Pulmonary Fibrosis across Canada, and

WHEREAS Pulmonary Fibrosis is a disease that generally progresses chronically and irreversibly;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that September 19, 2018 shall be known as

“Pulmonary Fibrosis Awareness Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
