ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS camping and using a recreational vehicle (RVing) are family-oriented activities that promote a sense of community, create life-long memories and encourage domestic and international visitors to discover British Columbia's rich natural landscape, and

WHEREAS the camping and RVing industries play an important role in the health of British Columbia's tourism sector, contributing more than \$600 million to British Columbia's GDP in 2014, and

WHEREAS campgrounds are an important source of economic activity, creating jobs and prosperity in small and rural communities across British Columbia, and

WHEREAS an estimated two million people will enjoy camping and RVing in British Columbia in the next two years, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia Lodging and Campgrounds Association is committed to representing small- and medium-sized campgrounds, supporting the camping, recreational vehicle and lodging sectors, and promoting excellence in service in the industry;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 21 to 26, 2019 shall be known as

“RVing and Camping Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
