ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS using a recreational vehicle (RVing) and camping are safe and affordable family-oriented activities that promote a sense of community, create life-long memories and encourage domestic and international visitors to discover British Columbia's rich natural landscape, and

WHEREAS the RVing and camping industries play an important role in the health of British Columbia's tourism sector, projected to contribute more than \$800 million to British Columbia's GDP in 2022, and

WHEREAS campgrounds are an important source of economic activity, creating jobs and prosperity in small and rural communities across British Columbia, and

WHEREAS an estimated 2 million people will enjoy RVing and camping in British Columbia in the next 2 years, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia Lodging and Campgrounds Association is committed to representing small- and medium-sized campgrounds; supporting the camping, recreational vehicle and lodging sectors; and promoting excellence in service in the industries;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 24 to 29, 2022, shall be known as

**“RVing and Camping Week”**

in the Province of British Columbia.
