WHEREAS by recognizing these acts of caring and kindness during this week, everyone will be encouraged to participate in making British Columbia a kinder, safer and better place to live, and

WHEREAS Real Acts of Caring Week is being observed in many cities and towns across this nation;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that February 10 to 16, 2019 shall be known as

“Real Acts of Caring Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
