WHEREAS Real Acts of Caring Week is observed in many cities and towns across this nation;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that February 14 to 20, 2021, shall be known as

“Real Acts of Caring Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
