ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS building participation in the Registered Disability Savings Plan is recognized as an important contributor to the financial security of people with disabilities in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia is committed to upholding and safeguarding the principles outlined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities, including full and effective participation and inclusion in society, and equality of opportunity, and

WHEREAS the government of British Columbia works with the financial and disability communities to promote increased financial security and participation in the Registered Disability Savings Plan to help people with disabilities and their families achieve a financially secure future;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that October 2021 shall be known as

“Registered Disability Savings Plan Awareness Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
