ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS technology in British Columbia is one of the fastest growing sectors in the province with technology and technology-enabled businesses representing an integral part of the economy, and

WHEREAS British Columbia's technology sector provides high-paying jobs with average annual earnings of 76 percent higher than the British Columbia industrial average, and

WHEREAS access to skilled talent is the number one challenge rated by British Columbia technology companies, and

WHEREAS in British Columbia women make up 20 percent of the workforce in technology, and

WHEREAS the provincial government is committed to fostering and celebrating the importance of women and girls in science, technology, engineering, art and design, and math (STEAM), and

WHEREAS the provincial government is committed to attracting more women and girls into STEAM, which will contribute to solving the issue of access to skilled talent afflicting British Columbia technology companies;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 1 to 7, 2018 shall be known as

**“Women and Girls in Science, Technology, Engineering,
Art and Design, and Math (STEAM) Week”**

in the Province of British Columbia.
