A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS it is desirable that workers, employees and the community at large observe the highest standards of worker safety, public safety and infrastructure protection in any activity involving ground disturbance, and

WHEREAS it is imperative that workers, employees and the community at large realize that damage to buried infrastructure can result in disruption to emergency services, water and sewer conductivity, telecommunications, electric power, cable television, the flow and supply of liquid petroleum and natural gas, which can cause vital outages for homes, businesses, financial institutions, hospitals, air traffic control and workplaces, and

WHEREAS the British Columbia Common Ground Alliance, a multi-faceted stakeholder group supporting safety, consistent practice and awareness in ground disturbance, together with the government of British Columbia and its agencies, promotes the open communication of occupational health and safety information among workers, employees and the community at large;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 2021 shall be known as

“Safe Digging Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
