ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS the Sikh Nation is a volunteer organization that partners with Canadian Blood Services each November to coordinate a series of blood donation events in several provinces across the country, and

WHEREAS the Sikh Nation is the Canadian Blood Services' largest contributor to the pledge-based Partners for Life program in the British Columbia and Yukon region and is one of Canadian Blood Services' largest donor groups in Canada, and

WHEREAS the Sikh Nation's blood donation campaign has grown from a small grassroots operation in British Columbia to include clinics across the world, and

WHEREAS Sikh Nation Blood Donation Month is an opportunity to raise awareness of and support for blood donation campaigns that help many people in British Columbia and across the world;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 2021 shall be known as

“Sikh Nation Blood Donation Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
