ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS square, round and clog dancing are relaxing and enjoyable forms of exercise to improve the physical and mental health of young and old alike, and

WHEREAS square, round and clog dancing take place in many cities across British Columbia and Canada and help relieve stress and develop flexibility, strength and coordination, and

WHEREAS square, round and clog dancing allow dancers to meet and enjoy the company of people from all walks of life, and

WHEREAS in 2021, British Columbia's square, round and clog dancing community has cancelled or postponed many events due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and Square, Round and Clog Dance Awareness Week is an opportunity to show support for the resilience of this community and a much-anticipated return to dancing when safe to do so;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that September 19 to 25, 2021, shall be known as

“Square, Round and Clog Dance Awareness Week”

in the Province of British Columbia.
