ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS British Columbia is a province of many festivals, events, cross-cultural understanding, inclusiveness and respect for one's neighbours, and

WHEREAS British Columbians of Scottish descent have contributed greatly to the history, culture and development of this province, and

WHEREAS Scotland's patron saint is St. Andrew whose death is traditionally recognized on November 30, and

WHEREAS many whose heritage includes the celebration of St. Andrew continue to contribute in many ways to the growth and development of the Province of British Columbia, and

WHEREAS British Columbia promotes multiculturalism and the full and free participation of all individuals in society;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 30, 2018 shall be known as

"St. Andrew's Day"

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.
