

Canada Province of British Columbia A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom, Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come — Greeting

WHEREAS government is committed to taking action to prevent the sexual exploitation of children and youth, and

WHEREAS it is important to raise public awareness about the sexual exploitation of children and youth because it is a growing problem in communities throughout British Columbia, and

WHEREAS the sexual exploitation of children and youth through prostitution, pornography, the exchange of drugs, alcohol, transportation or shelter is sexual abuse, which has a serious adverse impact on victims, their families and our communities, and

WHEREAS it is a serious offence under the Criminal Code of Canada to recruit, procure, buy or communicate to buy the sexual services of a person under the age of 18, and

WHEREAS local and provincial prevention, education, social intervention and enforcement strategies that fight child and youth sexual exploitation and provide greater protection to children and youth at risk of exploitation must be developed and implemented in British Columbia's communities;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that March 5 to 11, 2018 shall be known as

"Stop the Sexual Exploitation of Children and Youth Awareness Week"

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.
