ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS supply chains are important to all people and to organizations of all types and sizes in British Columbia, and

WHEREAS in times of crisis or emergency such as the COVID-19 pandemic, supply chains are even more critical as all British Columbians depend on them to thrive and succeed, and each day over 200 000 supply chain professionals in British Columbia manage the movement of essential goods, including food, medicine and fuel, and other critical supplies and services across British Columbia, and

WHEREAS supply chain communities in British Columbia are committed to becoming more sustainable, inclusive and diverse in order to support over 500 000 businesses and organizations in British Columbia in improving cost efficiency, leading innovation, driving economic growth, and increasing global competitiveness, and

WHEREAS the 2022 celebration of Supply Chain Week by supply chain communities in British Columbia focuses on five major themes: “Reflection & Agility,” “Recovery,” “Recognition,” “Responsibility” and “Reconciliation,” and

WHEREAS Supply Chain Week is an opportunity to honour the critical work of supply chain professionals and to recognize the resilience of the supply chain industry and its professionals in delivering essential goods, products and services relied upon by all British Columbians;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that September 12 to 16, 2022, shall be known as

**“Supply Chain Week”**

in the Province of British Columbia.
