ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS developing and maintaining a highly skilled technology workforce is vital to British Columbia's economic prosperity, and

WHEREAS the provincial skills training system is innovative and flexible to satisfy the needs of BC's diversified economy, attracting, retaining and developing the required technology skills and allowing the province to grow and flourish, and

WHEREAS the province wants to celebrate and recognize the application of technology skills in the work environment and the positive impact technology workers have on individuals, businesses and the economy, and

WHEREAS the province will act in support of the statements embedded in this proclamation to actively promote a vibrant and innovative technology skills training climate in BC;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that April 2019 shall be known as


“Technology Skills Appreciation Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
