ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,  
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the  
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS November 11, 2018 marks the 100 year anniversary of the Armistice Agreement that ended the First World War, and

WHEREAS the week of November 5 to 11, 2018 we will hold in observance to remember, honour and thank veterans who fought and died for our freedom, and

WHEREAS on November 5, we will remember those who sacrificed by inviting veterans' families to share stories of loved ones who fought in battle, and

WHEREAS to honour the significant contributions made by Canada's service members and their families to protect our sovereign, and

WHEREAS On November 11, we will gather to celebrate our nation's heroes by holding a Remembrance Day service, observing two minutes of silence and laying wreaths;

NOW KNOW YE THAT, We do by these presents proclaim and declare that November 5 to 11, 2018 shall be known as

**“Veterans’ Week”**

in the Province of British Columbia.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Our Province of British Columbia to be hereunto affixed.
