A Proclamation

ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS cardiovascular disease is the leading cause of death in women over 35 years of age worldwide, accounting for more deaths every year than all cancers combined, and

WHEREAS heart disease is on the rise in women, and some risk factors for and symptoms of heart disease are different for women than for men, and

WHEREAS the Canadian Women's Heart Health Alliance, a volunteer organization of cardiovascular professionals and patients, collaborates closely with the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada to raise awareness of evidence-informed strategies to transform clinical practice and improve women's heart health outcomes, and

WHEREAS Wear Red Canada Day is an opportunity to raise awareness of women's cardiovascular health issues and to show support for women at risk of and suffering from heart disease;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that February 13, 2021, shall be known as

“Wear Red Canada Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
