ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS periventricular nodular heterotopia (PVNH) is a rare neuronal migration disorder, and

WHEREAS PVNH can be associated with a spectrum of clinical manifestations from mild to life-threatening, including seizures which can be debilitating, and

WHEREAS increased awareness among medical professionals would be beneficial, and

WHEREAS increased education and research would be beneficial to find more effective treatments, and

WHEREAS headquartered in Vancouver, PVNH Support & Awareness is an international organization that offers support to individuals and families affected by PVNH and other neuronal heterotopia disorders in Canada and globally;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that August 7, 2022, shall be known as

“World PVNH Disorder Awareness Day”

in the Province of British Columbia.
