**To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting**

WHEREAS youth justice professionals protect the public by holding young people in conflict with the law accountable for their behaviour through rehabilitation and restorative approaches, and

WHEREAS youth justice professionals assist the Youth Justice Court in determining an appropriate and proportionate response to youth crime that distinguishes between social and criminal issues, and

WHEREAS youth justice professionals are highly skilled and provide guidance, support, mediation, treatment, education, crisis intervention and conflict resolution to youth, families and victims of crime, and

WHEREAS the dedication and commitment of youth justice professionals positively impacts the lives of thousands of British Columbians, and

WHEREAS youth justice professionals are honoured and respected for their commitment to keeping communities safe while supporting youth to become responsible contributing members of their communities;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 9 to 15, 2021, shall be known as


**“Youth Justice Week”**

in the Province of British Columbia.
